SPECIFICATIONS

These specifications are for one (1) new single place distribution class puller/tensioner trailer to be purchased by Traverse City Electric Light and Power. Bidder must fill in all blanks on the specification sheet in order for the bid to be considered a valid bid. Bidders must provide (1) copy of the Manufacturer's literature with the bid.

Pulling Unit: Constant speed, constant pull automatic levelwind onto removable rope cassettes Fully hydraulic, shift-on-the fly two speed provides 1500 lbs pull @ 188 fpm in high speed mode and 3000 lbs pull @ 94 fpm in high torque mode. Full feathering bi-directional valve provides for line pull and payout without levelwind compromise.		
Rope: Minimum of 2200' of 5/16" Amsteel Blue 13,700 lbs breaking strength rope w/ eyelets each end – orange color.		
Rope Storage: Rope can be stored loose in front load area or on Flexible Payout Bracket.		
Flexible Payout Bracket: 4-Cassette aluminum bracket allows rope to be stored in warehouse until ready to be deployed to the field. Unit allows payout from ground or pole mount. Unit is complete w/ adjustable rope overspin brake and (4) aluminum cassettes with nylon bushings each filled w/ 2200' of 5/16" Spectron 12+ rope – 13700 lbs breaking strength.		
Operator's Station: To allow for a single operator at a protected central console to control payout speed, pulling speed and tension, levelwind controls providing access to all puller controls.		
Underground Sheave: Removable bronze roller w/ integral mounting bracket attached at trailer rear for underground pulling. Unit stores left front load area.		
Underground Payout: Stainless steel receiver shaft to accommodate rope cassette w/ light adjustable spring loaded tension control for use in underground payout applications. Unit installed over left side trailer fender.

Stabilizers: Rear trailer two (2) adjustable telescoping outriggers (for trailer stability when unhitched) wheel chocks with holders embossed in frame		
Fenders: 12 gauge treated plate with 1" lip return and mud flaps. All walking surfaces shall be non-slip.		
Front jack: Heavy duty drop-leg jack with foot-operated actuation cam and spring assist up, 25" travel with sandshoe base.		
Pintle eye: 3" I.D. Adjustable.		
Safety chains: 2ea. stainless steel latch.		
Mechanical Brake: Positive sprocket engagement holds line tension regardless of power source, hydraulic system or drive chain status when power source is turned off.		
Trailer braking system: Must be electric & DOT compliant.		
LED Lighting & Electrical: LED sealed beam/wiring system w/ stop/turn/tail lights recessed in fully enclosed tube bumper to meet FMVSS 108. Sealed wiring harnesses with no junction boxes or spliced connections. SAE 7-way socket protected top sides and back w/ Almag housing. 1100-52 sealed breakaway w/ charging circuit and LED battery condition indicator w/ 450 C.C.A. maintenance free battery.		
Instructions & Placards: Laminated operating instructions contained in 6" diameter PVC weatherproof container for operator convenience and safety. Stainless steel etched rope winding instructions riveted to turntable top. Engraved pull and pressure chart provided at operator's console.		
Grounding Lug: 5/8" x 5" C95400 Aluminum bronze lug bolted to frame with bronze fasteners. 4 7/16"L x 5/8"Dia shaft.		
Chocks: (2) Galvanized All Weather # 8500 w/ gripstrut design and Almag holders.

Connection: Pressure and return lines routed with stainless steel tube to right front of power source panel. Dripless quick couples provided at pressure and return outlets		
Cover: Vinyl weatherproof cover included.		
Power Source Warranty: One year full parts coverage.

Bidder understands and agrees, if selected as the successful bidder, to accept a Purchase Order / Service Order / Contract from Traverse City Light and Power (TCL&P) and to provide proof of any required insurance.

Bidder submits this bid and agrees to meet or exceed all the TCL&P's requirements and specifications unless otherwise indicated in writing and attached hereto.

Bid forms are to be completed, including bid sheet, and submitted. Items not meeting specifications must be noted in the "comply" column and bidder shall fully describe every variance, exception, and/or deviation. Additional sheets may be used and submitted with bid.

Bidder is also required to submit, with the bid, the latest printed manufacturer's specifications and advertising literature on the equipment (including components) to be provided. Completed unit MUST be equipped in compliance with all applicable ANSI, OSHA, State and Federal Motor Vehicle Safety standards and regulations in effect at time of manufacture.

Bidder understands that TCL&P reserves the right to accept any or all bids in whole or in part and to waive irregularities in any bid in the best interest of TCL&P. The bids will be evaluated and awarded on the basis of the best value to TCL&P. Criteria used will include, but not be limited to, bidder/contractor's ability, qualifications, experience, type and amount of equipment, purchase price, maintenance cost(s), insurance, resale, license and permits and overall capability meeting the needs of TTCL&P. TCL&P is sales tax exempt – Government.

The Bidder certifies that it is in compliance with the City of Traverse City's Nondiscrimination Policy as set forth in Administrative Order No. 47 and Chapter 605 of the City's Codified Ordinances.

The Bidder certifies that none of the following circumstances have occurred with respect to the Bidder, an officer of the Bidder, or an owner of a 25% or more share in the Bidder's business, within 3 years prior to the bid:

 a) conviction of a criminal offense incident to the application for or performance of a contract;



- b) conviction of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, receiving stolen property, or any other offense which currently, seriously and directly reflects on the Bidder's business integrity;
- c) conviction under state or federal antitrust statutes;
- d) attempting to influence a public employee to breach ethical conduct standards; or
- e) conviction of a criminal offense or other violation of other state, local, or federal law, as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction or an administrative proceeding, which in the opinion of the City indicates that the bidder is unable to perform responsibility or which reflects a lack of integrity that could negatively impact or reflect upon TCL&P, including but not limited to, any of the following offenses or violations of:
 - i. The Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act.
 - ii. A persistent and knowing violation of the Michigan Consumer Protection Act
 - iii. Willful or persistent violations of the Michigan Occupational Health and Safety Act.
 - iv. A violation of federal, local, or state civil rights, equal rights, or non-discrimination laws, rules or regulations.
 - v. Repeated or flagrant violations of laws related to the payment of wages and fringe benefits.
- f) the loss of a license or the right to do business or practice a profession, the loss or suspension of which indicates dishonesty, a lack of integrity, or a failure or refusal to perform in accordance with the ethical standards of the business or profession in question.

Pre-delivery Inspection: Successful bidder shall make a complete inspection of vehicle (and/or equipment) to insure it meets specifications and perform any pre-delivery service(s) required before the vehicle is delivered. Acceptance shall be subject to complete inspection and approval of TCL&P.
