

**TRAVERSE CITY LIGHT & POWER
REQUEST FOR BIDS
UNDERGROUND POWER CABLE**

Traverse City Light & Power is requesting sealed bids for the furnishing and delivery (F.O.B. Traverse City Light & Power, Traverse City, Michigan) of medium voltage underground cable. Cable specification and quantities are listed below. Cable delivery is required no later than June 4, 2018. Anticipated project award date is March 13, 2018.

8,700 feet of 750kCM 15kV 220mil CU 1/3rd Concentric Neutral MV cable:

- 750kCM class B copper compact round center conductor
- 90°C continuous operating temperature, 130°C emergency rating (MV-90 minimum).
- EPR insulated, 220mil (133%) insulation level.
- Semi-conducting, extruded, strand and insulation screens.
- One-third capacity outer neutral conductor comprised of bare copper wires.
- Sunlight resistant polyethylene outer jacket with three red stripes.
- Sequential footage marker printed on outer jacket.
- Kerite or Okonite only.
- (3) 2,900' non-returnable wood reels.
- Length tolerances Minimum -0%. Maximum +5%.

Provide quotation for copper cables based on a copper price of \$3.25 per pound with metals escalation. Alternate firm cable prices without metals escalation can also be submitted.

Bids must include unit cost, extended cost, and delivery schedule. Traverse City Light & Power is a political subdivision (municipality) of the State of Michigan and is exempt from state sales taxes and will provide appropriate exemption certificate upon acceptance of the bid. Following acceptance by TCL&P, a Purchase Order will be issued to the successful vendor.

Sealed bids must be submitted to **Traverse City Light & Power, 1131 Hastings Street, Traverse City, MI 49686** no later than 11:00am, Tuesday, March 6, 2018. Electronic copies will NOT be accepted.

Traverse City Light & Power reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, waive technicalities, and to accept the bid deemed to be in the best interest of TCL&P. Sealed bids must be addressed to Ms. Stephanie Tvardek. Address all questions to Mr. Anthony Chartrand, TCL&P.

SHIPMENT AND DELIVERY

Material must be delivered on an open deck trailer and F.O.B. destination with freight prepaid and allowed to the following location. Acceptance of the cable will be at the delivery time following an inspection by TCL&P. Provide notice of deliver to Traverse City Light & Power at least 24 hours ahead of the delivery. Delivery will be accepted only between the hours of 8AM

to 3:30PM, local time. Failure to give advance delivery notification may result in delayed unloading of the equipment.
