Subject: Amended Fiber to the Premises tariff rates

Staff has expanded service offerings for TCLPfiber to include new additions to TCLPfiber's enterprise, VOIP, and premise equipment offerings and have included rate tariff updates within this memo. These monthly recurring rates were established through coordination with Fujitsu, TCLPfiber's partner, and are presented as follows:

Staff is presenting the rates for the Board to tentatively approve and set a public hearing. This process is set forth by the City Charter, Chapter XVIII (h), "After a public hearing and public notice the Board shall fix the rates to be charged for electricity, heat, steam and other utilities sold and services rendered by the Department. Rates shall be fair, reasonable, compensatory and shall be uniform for all consumers within the same class; but different rate schedules may be applied to different classes of consumers as determined by the Board."

It is staff's recommendation that the Board tentatively approve the Fiber to the Premises rates and set a public hearing for the proposed rates at its August 12, 2022 meeting. If after Board discussion you agree with staff's recommendation the following motion would be appropriate:
